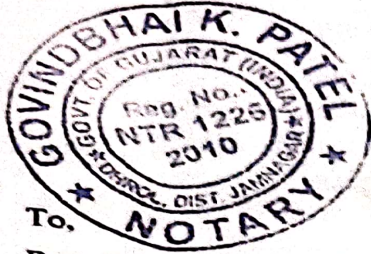

Under Section 18 of the Free and Compulsory Education of Children Act 2009 and Right to Compulsory Education Rules 2012 as well as Mumbai Primary Education Rules 1949 to start a new Lower Primary / Upper Primary School from June 2019, the online application has received from your School Trust and the enclosure attached with the application based on the following conditions,

you are allowed to start non-granted Lower Primary (1 to 5) / Upper Primary School (6 to 8) from June 2019.

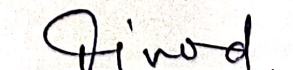
Your school will have English Medium and from June 2019 there will be one class for standard 1 to 5 (Lower Primary) each.

**Conditions:**

1. It will be the responsibility of the School Trust to meet and maintain the conditions for school accreditation.
2. The School Trust will be responsible for complying with and maintaining all the provisions of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009, the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2012 and the Mumbai Right to Primary Education Act 1949.
3. In addition to the Acts and the rules framed under it, the School Trust shall be responsible for complying with the rules, bye-laws, resolutions, circulars and instructions, etc., issued by the State Government from time to time.
4. The School should admit the children of the weaker class and the children of disadvantaged group in the adjoining areas in Standard – 1 including Pre – Primary classes as per 25% of the strength of that particular standard as well as Free and Compulsory Education should be provided till its completion. The concerned office has to be contacted for its implementation.
5. Capitation fees are prohibited and therefore the Trust Board or School will not be able to accept goods in return for any Capitation fees or other donations or such fees.
6. The School should not adopt any procedure like admission test of the child or his / her parents or guardians for the purpose of admission.
7. The School should not refuse admission to any child on the basis of religion, caste or creed, place of birth or any of them due to lack of proof of age.
8. The School should ensure that:
  - 1) Any child admitted should not be detained or expelled from the School in any standard till the completion of Elementary Education in the school or should be dealt with subject to the existing rules of class promotion.
  - 2) No child is subjected to physical punishment or mental torture.
  - 3) Every child who completes Elementary Education should be awarded a certificate as prescribed under Rule 30.
  - 4) As per the provisions of Acts, admission has to be given to a student with special needs with disabilities.

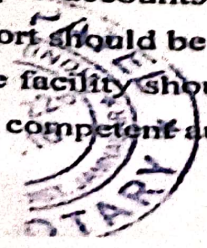

- 5) Teachers with academic qualifications prescribed by the Government from time to time will have to be recruited.
- 6) Teacher – student ratio should be as per rules. The area of classroom also should be as per the rules and should have all the necessary facilities.
- 7) The teacher has to perform his / her duty as specified under sub – section (1) of Section 24 of the RTI Act.
- 8) It will be the responsibility of School Board to see that the teacher himself cannot give private tuitions.
- 9) The School shall follow a transparent and fair admission process following the guidelines and orders issued by Central Government or the State Government or the Director.

The School will have to impart the education as per the syllabus prepared on the basis of course prepared by the appropriate authority.

1. The School will have to enroll the students in proportion to the facilities available in the school as decided in the Section – 19 of the RTI Act.
1. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in Clause – 19 of the RTI Act in particular to maintain school website to provide any information and filling in the correct reliable District Information System for Education (DISE) data within the stipulated time every year and all the conditions of RTI Rule – 13 must be complied with.
2. Unauthorized classes should not be conducted inside the school premise or outside the school under the same name.
3. The School building or other construction or school ground shall be used teaching skills development purpose only.
4. The School must be run by a registered society under the Society Registration Act – 1860 (21<sup>st</sup> of 1860) or by Public Trust or Company constituting laws in force at the time.
5. The School may not be run for the benefits of any individual, group or association of people.
5. The Chartered Accountant should have the accounts audited and certified and the proper accounts should be prepared as per the rules. A copy of the audited report should be sent to the competent authority every year.
7. The facility should be available along with the recording of CCTV camera and the competent authority should be sure about it.

18. Necessary measures for school safety should be taken within the time limit as per the guideline of National Disaster Authority. School Safety Policy - 2016 will have to be implemented.
19. The safety of students and staff should be ensured by taking necessary steps from time to time.
20. The school board cannot insist or compel the students / parents to buy certain types of books, literature, uniforms or shoes from their own institution from a particular institution or agency or from a certain brand or company.
21. The provisions of Gujarat Self Finance Schools (Fee Regulation) Act-2017 and the rules made under it will be applicable to this school and a statement of commitment to comply with it will have to be submitted.
22. The competent authority or a person authorized by him and the inspector / officers of the Education Department will be allowed to inspect the school.
23. The school must use only Government approved curriculum and textbooks approved from time to time.
24. The School tuition fees and pay scales for academic and non-academic staff should be approved by the government.
25. The records, statistics and certificates provided by the school principal or administrators should be reliable.
26. The school shall provide the reports and information as directed by the Director and the competent authority from time to time and comply with the orders issued by the State Government / Local Authority to fulfill the condition of accreditation to continue the school or to rectify the deficiencies in the functioning of the school.
27. The school may not change the name of the school, change the location of the school or change the management system of the school without the prior permission of the Competent Authority.
28. Under normal circumstances, the school should start in the same year in which the school is sanctioned. If the school is not started within 6 months after the approval is given, the permission given will be automatically revoked.
29. When required, the school building should be vacated by the school administrator for public examination and in the public interest.
30. The school has to abide by all the resolutions / circulars / instructions / rules issued by the government from time to time.
